### COURSE SUMMARY

The Certificate II in Salon Assistant (SHB20216) is the entry level qualification for the hairdressing industry. This course will prepare you to effectively work as an Assistant in a hairdressing salon where you will work under the direct supervision of a qualified hairdresser.

You will gain the knowledge and skills to support hairdressers in a salon – in particular with shampooing, colouring, blow-drying and braiding hair, maintaining hairdressing tools, scheduling appointments, recommending and selling products, and applying workplace health and safety.

Successful students will graduate with a nationally recognised qualification which can be used to seek employment as a Salon Assistant or as a pathway to a hairdressing apprenticeship. For students completing this as part of the VET in Schools program, the successful completion of the following units of competency is recognised towards 45 SACE Credits. If students decide to continue studies after gaining this qualification, some units may be available for credit transfer.
